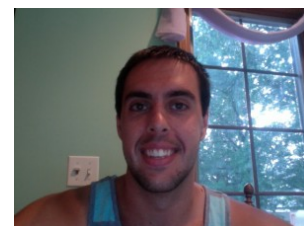
Managing Editor – Natalie Kouba, kouban1@tcnj.edu

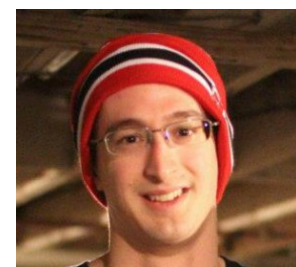
News Editor – Jack Meyers, meyersj2@tcnj.edu

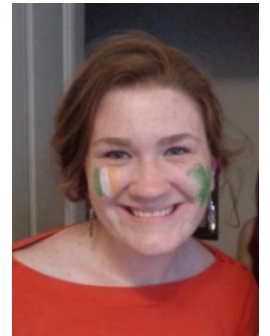
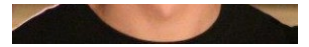
Sports Editor – Peter Fiorilla, fiorilp1@tcnj.edu

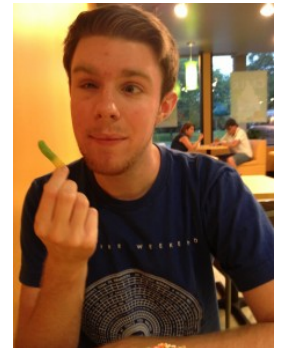
Features Editor – Emma Colton, coltone1@tcnj.edu

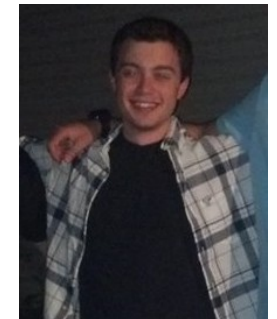
Web Editor – Regina Yorkgitis, yorkgir1@tcnj.edu
