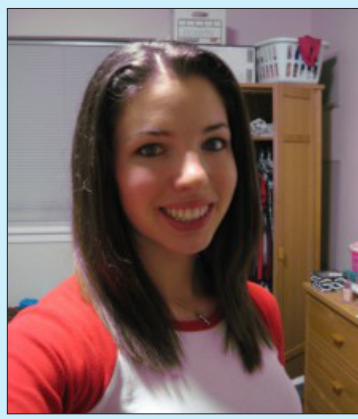


**Matt Huston**, Editor-in-Chief

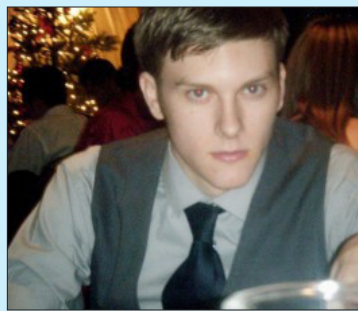
**Tom O'Dell**, Photo Editor

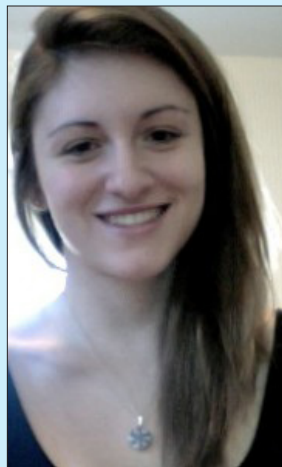
**Danny Pazos**, Opinions Editor

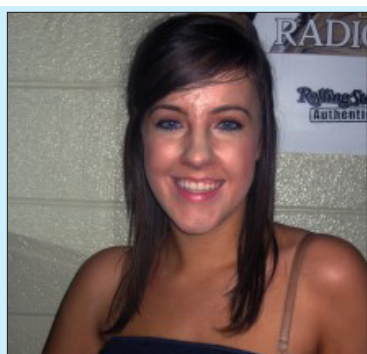
**Tom Ciccone**, Nation & World Editor
